*With over 273 lakes and ponds, the Lakes Region is a great place to spend your next camping trip. Picturesque New England towns line the lakes with unique shops, museums, and restaurants, while others sit where the views of mountains peaks are the best around.*

The Lakes Region area is home to the largest lake in the state, Lake Winnepesaukee, with 288 miles of shoreline and 274 islands. Joining Lake “Winni” are other bodies of water that give visiting campers an abundance of places to explore. These lakes include Squam Lake, Winnisquam Lake, Newfound Lake, and Lake Wentworth just to name a few, where water enthusiasts enjoy swimming, boating, kayaking, paddle boarding, and waterskiing.

Along with the wealth of lakes, rivers, and ponds, the Lakes Region is home to many beautiful mountains big and small. Visitors of all ages and abilities can explore hiking, biking, and walking trails for any skill levels. Spend a day hiking through the trails at the Castle in the Clouds in Moultonborough or take a couple of hours biking down the Cotton Valley rail trail from Wolfeboro to Wakefield.

Even if you are not an outdoor enthusiast, there are plenty of activities to keep you busy in the Lakes Region. There are an abundance of museums, farms, shops, and restaurants that will fill your day with excitement. Visit the Remick Country Doctor Museum & Farm in Tamworth or take in a show at the Winnepesaukee Playhouse at Meredith. Stop for lunch in downtown Wolfeboro or jump on the M/S Mount Washington and take a 3-hour tour of the big lake. However you choose to spend your day, you will not be disappointed in the Lakes Region of New Hampshire.
