With over 273 lakes and ponds, the Lakes Region is a great place to spend your next camping trip. Picturesque New England towns line the lakes with unique shops, museums, and restaurants, while others sit where the views of mountains peaks are the best around.

However you choose to spend your day, you will not be disappointed in the Lakes Region of New Hampshire.
