The Lakes Region of New Hampshire is the state's premier destination for water enthusiasts, centered around the sprawling Lake Winnepesaukee and the numerous other pristine bodies of water like Squam Lake and Lake Winnisquam. The region's charm is found in its vibrant lakeside towns, such as Wolfeboro (known as the "Oldest Summer Resort in America"), Meredith, and Laconia.

Visitors can experience the lakes firsthand via scenic M/S Mount Washington cruises, tranquil kayaking trips on quieter waters, or by renting a boat for exploring the lakes on your own time. The shorelines are dotted with inviting beaches, like the one at Ellacoya State Park, while the Winnepesaukee Scenic Railroad offers relaxing journeys with picturesque views of the water and surrounding landscape. Beyond the water, the Lakes Region offers a wealth of diverse activities throughout the year. Explore the natural beauty of the inland with hiking trails at Castle in the Clouds, a historic mountaintop mansion offering stunning vistas, and the educational Squam Lakes Natural Science Center in Holderness, which features native wildlife exhibits and lake cruises.

The region successfully blends outdoor adventure with family-friendly entertainment, exemplified by attractions such as Funspot in Laconia, one of the world's largest arcades. With its combination of natural splendor, historic charm, and recreational opportunities, the Lakes Region provides a dynamic New England experience.
